Lorna Toolis was a Canadian fan, and the librarian of the Merril Collection of Science Fiction, Speculation and Fantasy in Toronto for over 30 years. She was a member of the Edmonton SF & Comics Arts Society and one of the editors of its clubzine, *Neology*. Lorna passed away in 2021. She is our Ghost Guest of Honour.

Tanya Huff is a Canadian author of fantasy and science fiction, including the *Valor Confederation* series, *Keeper's Chronicles, Smoke* series, and more. Her *Blood Books* series pairs a detective with vampire, and was adapted for television as *Blood Ties*. Tanya is our Toastmaster.
