## 16th North American Science Fiction Convention—2024 Site Selection Ballot

Everyone who votes will become a Supporting member of the selected 16<sup>th</sup> NASFiC Rules and Instructions (Please read carefully):

**Eligibility:** To be eligible to vote, you must be a living, natural person and either an Attending or Supporting Member of Pemmi-Con. Ballots cast for memberships held by non-natural persons, such as "Guest of" memberships, clubs, toys, et cetera, may only be voted as "No Preference." Single-day members who have memberships for Thursday or Friday of Pemmi-Con can vote at the convention on that day in person only. If you have more than one membership, every ballot you cast after the first must be voted as "No Preference."

If you do not have a membership, and want to vote, you can purchase a Supporting Membership on the Pemmi-Con website <a href="https://main.Pemmi-Con.ca/membership/">https://main.Pemmi-Con.ca/membership/</a>. To purchase a Pemmi-Con Supporting Membership with a ballot submitted by postal mail, include a separate payment for the membership payable to "Pemmi-Con."

You may cast your signed ballot prior to Pemmi-Con via postal mail. You may also cast your ballot in person at Pemmi-Con. We will accept signed paper ballots carried in by hand, including ballots signed on paper and then scanned in and printed off.

You must pay an Advance Supporting Membership (Voting Fee) of CA\$40 or US\$30 to vote in the NASFiC 2024 site selection. You may pay for your voting fee with a personal check or money order in Canadian or US funds, payable to "NASFiC", mailed with your ballot to the address below. If you wish to pay via credit card, you must prepay your voting fee on the Pemmi-Con website. Instructions on paying the voting fee online will be found on the site at <a href="https://main.Pemmi-Con.ca/sf/nasfic-site-selection/">https://main.Pemmi-Con.ca/sf/nasfic-site-selection/</a>. Please follow the instructions for paying the voting fee for the 2024 NASFiC site selection. You will receive a voting token (transaction ID); please enter it on your ballot.

Do not mail cash. Mail ballots must be *received* by July 11, 2023. Postmark date does not count.

If you choose to cast your ballot at Pemmi-Con, you may pay the Advance Supporting Membership at that time. Voting continues at Pemmi-Con until 6PM CDT on Friday July 21, 2023. If you delegate someone to hand-carry your ballot, please either purchase your Pemmi-Con (supporting) membership online or give your voting agent separate payment for your membership.

**Voting:** Site Selection ballots are tallied by preferential balloting procedures. The winner is the first bid to receive a majority of those ballots expressing a preference. This means that you should indicate your favorite selection with a "1," your next favorite with a "2," and so on.

If you mark an "X" with no other marks, that will count as a "1" for that bid and no other preferences. Please do not use any marks other than these.

**Electronic Voting:** Members wishing to vote electronically should first purchase a voting token through the Pemmi-Con website at <a href="https://reg.Pemmi-Con.ca/">https://reg.Pemmi-Con.ca/</a>. Include the voting token number (last six characters of your transaction ID) on your ballot, scan or take a photograph of your ballot, and email the scanned ballot or photo to **SiteSelection@Pemmi-Con.ca**.

#### **Mailing Instructions:**

- 1. Mark your vote and fill in the membership and payment details on the other side of this sheet.
- 2. Include your name, email (if you have one), and postal address on your ballot. You must sign your ballot. Ballots lacking a name, postal address, or signature will be counted as "No Preference." In addition to being used to validate the ballot, we will provide the voter's name, email, and postal address to the bids for voter validation and membership purposes in the winning convention. This information will otherwise be kept confidential.
- 3. After filling out both sections of the ballot, fold the ballot along the dashed line below, then tape the fold shut at the solid line to conceal your vote from casual viewing prior to the ballot count.
- 4. You can send your ballot by postal mail to the address below or cast it in person at Pemmi-Con. Postal mail ballots must include any payment necessary (**do not mail cash**). You may also authorize someone else to deliver your ballot to the convention for you.

The deadline for receipt of mail-in ballots is July 11, 2023. The deadline for receipt of emailed ballots is 4 PM CDT on Friday, July 21, 2023. Voting at the convention will end at 6 PM CDT on Friday July 21, 2023.
